SUBJECT: Resolution authorizing execution of a purchase order with 72 Hour LLC dba National Auto Fleet Group for one replacement Ford Super Duty F550 Truck with Scelzi Crane Body in an amount not-to-exceed \$262,663.

RECOMMENDED ACTION

Staff recommends the City Council adopt a resolution authorizing execution of a purchase order with 72 Hour LLC dba National Auto Fleet Group in Watsonville, California for the purchase of one replacement Ford Super Duty F550 truck with Scelzi Crane Body under Sourcewell contract #091521-NAF for a not-to-exceed amount of \$262,663.

DECISION TYPE

SUMMARY

Based on the City of Livermore's Fleet Policy and the 25-year Fleet Replacement Plan, it is time to replace WRD025, a 2008 Ford F350 sewer system service truck. Staff have determined that the vehicle that best meets the needs of the department is the 2026 F550 Super Duty with Scelzi Enterprises, Inc. and 72 Hour LLC dba National Auto Fleet Group is the local Sourcewell (formally National Joint Powers Alliance, NJPA) contractor for Ford vehicles in Watsonville, California.

DISCUSSION

The Ford F550 truck with the Scelzi service crane body is critical in performing routine maintenance, customer service repairs, and emergency service work on the City's Sewer Collection System, as well as at the remote lift stations. The service crane body allows staff to carry all the tools, components and parts needed to make repairs and perform maintenance in the field.

The City of Livermore's Fleet Policy recommends replacement of light duty trucks with service bodies at 7-10 years or 85,000 miles. This truck will be replacing a truck that is 18 years old that is equipped with

a crane that is not capable of hoisting the larger pumps and trench plates that the Collections section maintains and uses. The replacement of this truck with the addition of the crane capacity will allow the section to hoist pumps from the lift stations for maintenance and repairs and utilize trench plates on jobs that cannot be completed during the same day and need to be covered. This will allow staff the ability to perform service and repairs in less time and have a fully equipped vehicle for customer service and emergency calls.

Pursuant to LMC Section 2.68.370, staff recommends purchasing this replacement vehicle utilizing Sourcewell Acceptance and Award contract #091521-NAF. The Sourcewell bid procedure for the replacement vehicles meets the City's municipal code requirement and therefore can be awarded to National Auto Fleet Group. The Sourcewell Cooperative Purchasing Program assists local governments in reducing costs through this government-to-government procurement service. This program is available to local government entities and qualifying non-profit corporations. The City of Livermore is currently a registered member. The purchase through Sourcewell Acceptance and Award contract #091521-NAF will expedite the delivery of these replacement vehicles.

FISCAL AND ADMINISTRATIVE IMPACTS

The replacement purchase of this vehicle is budgeted in the Fleet Services Internal Service Fund (730) for FY 2025-26 and is identified in the Fleet 25-Year replacement plan.
