### **DECISION TYPE**

#### SUMMARY

The Livermore Teen Academy is an annual, three-week City program that the Library has administered since 2016. There are total of seven "class days," where students learn how local government works and participate in life skills workshops. Additionally, all participants work for eight days in an internship in one of the different City departments. This year, the Library took on four interns during this program.

#### DISCUSSION

While a presentation has been brought before the Library Board of Trustees on the overall Livermore Teen Academy program before, staff have not discussed in detail the type of opportunities students have interning with the Library. This has included helping with storytimes, planning programs, collection development, and more.
