**SUMMARY**

At the request of the Airport Commission, staff is presenting an overview of the Airport Capital Improvement Program.

**DISCUSSION**

This item is being brought forward in response to the Airport Commission's request for an early look at upcoming airport capital planning efforts and funding strategy.

The draft FAA Airport Capital Improvement Program outlines a phased sequence of airfield planning, safety, pavement, lighting, and infrastructure projects extending through 2034. Near-term projects include the Airport Layout Plan update, runway rubber removal and remarking, perimeter fencing and security upgrades, and equipment acquisition. Future-year projects focus on runway geometry and pavement construction, airfield lighting upgrades, entrance road improvements, and multi-phase pavement preservation and rehabilitation.

The draft Livermore Capital Improvement Program identifies locally initiated projects, including the Aviation Innovation Center, the proposed Public Safety Complex, and recurring internal airfield improvements such as pavement sealcoating, hangar door replacement, roof and facility repairs.

All projects remain subject to additional technical development, environmental review (as applicable), FAA coordination for federally eligible items, budget approval, and City Council authorization before

implementation.
