Historic Preservation Commission 1 Vacancy

Reappointment to a regular term ending May 1, 2030

Library Board of Trustees 2 Vacancies

Appointment to a regular term ending June 1, 2029

Re-appointment to a regular term ending June 1, 2029

- Nancy Olavarrieta

Livermore Housing Authority 1 Vacancy

Appointment to an unexpired term ending January 1, 2027 and a possible regular term ending January 1, 2031, subject to City Council approval.

- Dan Knight

Upon the City Council's confirmation of the appointments by motion, the City Clerk will administer the oath of office to new appointees.
