SUBJECT: Resolution authorizing minor modifications to the Third Amended and Restated Agreement between the City of Livermore and Livermore Sanitation, Inc. for Solid Waste, Recyclable Materials, and Compostable Materials Services

RECOMMENDED ACTION

Staff recommends the City Council authorize the City Manager to execute a resolution to authorize minor modifications to the Third Amended and Restated Agreement between the City of Livermore and Livermore Sanitation, Inc. for Solid Waste, Recyclable Materials, and Compostable Materials Services to add an approved composting site, clarify the scope of materials eligible for on-call single-family clean-up services, and include an additional Livermore Sanitation signatory.

SUMMARY

On April 27, 2020, the City Council adopted a resolution authorizing the execution of the Third Amended and Restated Agreement with Livermore Sanitation, Inc. for Solid Waste, Recyclable Materials, and Compostable Materials Services (Franchise Agreement). This action extended the Franchise Agreement term for a minimum period of 10 years, until June 30, 2030, and included new trucks and other equipment, and enhanced services for the Livermore rate payers.

Staff recommends that the City Council approve the Third Amendment to the Franchise Agreement to incorporate proposed minor modifications to Section 5.13.3 to allow the use of Waste Management Altamont Landfill & Resource Recovery to process Compostable Materials collected from the City of Livermore, update Section 5.2.2 3. D. to include both mattresses and box springs as one item of furniture for bulky item collection for single-family residences and multi-family complexes, and add an approved signatory to sign on behalf of LSI.

DISCUSSION

On April 27, 2020, the City Council adopted a resolution authorizing the execution of the Third Amended and Restated Agreement with Livermore Sanitation, Inc. for Solid Waste, Recyclable Materials, and Compostable Materials Services (Franchise Agreement). This action extended the Franchise Agreement

term for a minimum period of 10 years, until June 30, 2030, and included new trucks and other equipment, and enhanced services for the Livermore rate payers.

The Franchise Agreement allows the City's Contract Manager to administratively approve certain temporary modifications to the Franchise Agreement pending City Council approval. Staff previously approved the use of the Waste Management Altamont Landfill & Resource Recovery, located at 10840 Altamont Pass Rd, Livermore, CA, to process Compostable Materials collected from the City of Livermore as an Approved Composting Site. In addition, current Franchise Agreement language allows only one mattress or one box spring to be collected as part of the on call bulky pick-up program.

Staff is now recommending approval of the Third Amendment to the Franchise Agreement to incorporate language updates to modify Section 5.13.3 to allow the use of the Waste Management Altamont Landfill & Resource Recovery as an Approved Composting Site. In addition, staff is recommending updates to Section 5.2.2 3. D. to include both mattresses and box springs as one item of furniture for bulky item collection for single-family residences and multi-family complexes. Finally, Waste Connections Regional Vice President, Dan Schooler, will be added as an approved signatory to sign on behalf of LSI.

FISCAL AND ADMINISTRATIVE IMPACTS

No fiscal or administrative impacts are anticipated as a result of this proposed modification.
