SUBJECT: Resolution authorizing the display of the Prisoner of War / Missing in Action (POW-MIA) flag for the week of November 11-16, 2025.

RECOMMENDED ACTION

Staff recommends the City Council adopt a resolution authorizing the display of the Prisoner of War / Missing in Action (POW-MIA) flag on the flagpole at the Civic Center Campus for the week of November 11-16, 2025.

SUMMARY

At the request of Mayor Marchand, consistent with the Commemorative Flag Display policy this agenda item provides a resolution for Council consideration which would authorize the display of the Prisoner of War / Missing in Action (POW-MIA) flag at the Civic Center Campus for the week of November 11-16, 2025.

DISCUSSION

On September 23, 2019, Council adopted a Commemorative Flag Display policy. The policy allows a Council Member to request display of a commemorative flag at the Civic Center Campus, on the City of Livermore flagpole, beneath the City of the Livermore flag. Once a request has been made by a Council Member, the Council will consider the request at a duly noticed public meeting.

The City's policy is constructed to allow the display of commemorative flags as a form of government expression. Such flags may be displayed for a period of time that is reasonable or customary for the subject that is to be commemorated, but no more than thirty-one consecutive days.
