SUBJECT: Confirm Advisory Body appointments to the Commission for the Arts, Historic Preservation Commission, Library Board of Trustees, and the Livermore Housing Authority Board of Commissioners, and direct the City Clerk to administer the oath of office.

RECOMMENDED ACTION

The City Council Subcommittee on Advisory Bodies recommends the City Council confirm the advisory body appointments to the Commission for the Arts, Historic Preservation Commission, Library Board of Trustees, and the Livermore Housing Authority Board of Commissioners, and direct the City Clerk to administer the oath of office.

SUMMARY

On May 29, 2025, the City Council Subcommittee on Advisory Bodies interviewed applicants for vacancies on the Commission for the Arts, Historic Preservation Commission, Library Board of Trustees, and the Livermore Housing Authority Board of Commissioners, and have submitted their recommendation for City Council consideration and appointment.

DISCUSSION

On May 29, 2025, the City Council Subcommittee on Advisory Bodies interviewed applicants for vacancies on the Commission for the Arts, Historic Preservation Commission, Library Board of Trustees, and the Livermore Housing Authority Board of Commissioners, and recommends confirmation of the following appointments:

- Lainie Pascall

Appointment to regular term ending June 1, 2028

Livermore Housing Authority 1 Vacancy

Appointment to an unexpired term ending January 1, 2028

- Terry Buttchen
