### **SUMMARY**

Livermore Public Library and the Housing & Human Services Division of the Livermore Community Development Department initially began collaborating on a self-sufficiency program for Livermore Valley Joint Unified School District (LVJUSD) parents transitioning from homelessness to affordable housing. The Library's lead volunteer for Basic Tech Help was approached to help develop a workshop, which included email creation, general online searching, and basic cyber security. A librarian covered relevant Library resources, including Career Online High School, adult literacy program, Basic Tech Help drop-in service.

### **DISCUSSION**

At this first event hosted at Leahy Square, there were six attendees, but with high impact. Two new library cards were issued, one new COHS survey completed, one expressed interest in the Livermore Public Library Adult Literacy Program. Attendees gained the following skills:

- Gmail account creation
- Online safety (avoiding scam emails, texts, calls)

Staff strengthened partnership with the Livermore Housing Authority and City colleagues in Housing and Human Services.

More classes were requested, with a follow up event currently being discussed.
