SUMMARY

The Livermore Public Library is creating a dedicated space designed just for teens at the Civic Center Library. The new area will include comfortable seating and flexible spaces for teens to collaborate, study, connect with friends, and work on projects. The architectural firm Noll & Tam was selected to design the project, and has been working with staff since November of 2024. Teenagers' perspectives have been included in the conversation around the design of this space from the very beginning through the Livermore Youth Council. The project is entering the stage where public input around furniture and equipment is welcome, before bidding and construction begin later this year.

DISCUSSION
