SUBJECT: Update on the partnership with Marylin Avenue STEAM Academy during the 2024/25 school year.

RECOMMENDED ACTION

Staff recommends the Library Board of Trustees receive the report.

SUMMARY

Marylin Avenue STEAM Academy, an elementary school located in close proximity to Livermore Public Library's Rincon Branch Library, had its school media center closed during the 2024/25 school year for remodeling. Livermore Public Library was approached to see whether the Rincon Branch Library could serve as attending students' library while these renovations were taking place. After a dialogue, details were worked out so that this partnership could move forward.

DISCUSSION

The partnership between the Rincon Branch Library and Marylin Avenue STEAM Academy was a major success this school year, allowing local students to become more familiar with their local library and access books they would not have otherwise had access to. Usage of the Rincon Branch Library increased, and the hope is that students will continue to frequent the Rincon Branch Library during the next school year even with their new media center.
