**SUBJECT:** Resolution authorizing execution of an agreement with Chrisp Company for on-call signing and striping maintenance services in an amount not-to-exceed \$1,000,000 and a term ending December 31, 2031.

**RECOMMENDED ACTION**

Staff recommends the City Council adopt a resolution authorizing the City Manager to execute an Agreement for Services with Chrisp Company for on-call signing and striping maintenance services in an amount not-to-exceed \$1,000,000 and a term ending December 31, 2031.

**DECISION TYPE**

**SUMMARY**

As part of the annual Miscellaneous Traffic Signing and Striping projects, Chrisp Company has been helping the City of Livermore (City) to maintain City streets by removing, replacing, and/or installing traffic signs, striping and pavement markings through on-call Agreements for Services. The total amount allowed in the current on-call agreement with Chrisp Company will be exhausted soon. Staff recommends the execution of a new Agreement for Services with Chrisp Company for an amount not-to-exceed \$1,000,000 through December 31, 2031.

**DISCUSSION**

The Livermore Engineering Division published a Request for Proposals (RFP) for on-call signing and striping maintenance services from qualified contractors on November 7, 2025. The City only received one response from Chrisp Company, the City's current on-call signing and striping contractor.

Over the past ten years, Chrisp Company has been providing on-call signing and striping maintenance services to support the annual Miscellaneous Traffic Signing and Striping projects, as part of the City's Capital Improvements Plan (CIP).

Through the annual Miscellaneous Traffic Signing and Striping projects, Chrisp Company has been helping the City maintain road conditions in Livermore by replacing road signs, striping and pavement markings. In addition, as traffic conditions and the California Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices (CAMUTCD) standards change and new traffic laws become effective, existing signing, striping and pavement markings constantly require modifications. Chrisp Company has been helping the City to accommodate the required changes, such as installing red curbs and painted bulb-out curbs in response to Assembly Bill 413, installing high visibility crosswalks and appropriate signages to enhance pedestrian safety, installing bike lane striping, relevant pavement markings and appropriate signages to enhance safety for bicyclists, etc.

City staff have found Chrisp Company's work to be satisfactory as they perform their work efficiently, provide industry and local expertise, and demonstrate rapid and professional responsiveness.

This agreement will allow Chrisp Company to continue providing on-call services for the annual Miscellaneous Traffic Signing and Striping projects with an amount not-to-exceed \$1,000,000 over the next five years through December 31, 2031.

### **FISCAL AND ADMINISTRATIVE IMPACTS**

Funding for services rendered under this agreement will be derived from Miscellaneous Traffic Signing and Striping (project TC212131) and Miscellaneous Traffic Signing and Striping (project TC202615) in the approved 2025-2030 Capital Improvement Plan. No additional appropriations are required.
