RECOMMENDED ACTION

Staff recommends the Airport Commission receive information on aircraft incident that occurred on May 6, 2026.

SUMMARY

On May 6, 2026, at approximately 1:25 p.m., an LVK tenant operating a single-engine Cessna 170B made a safe landing in the vegetated area north of West Jack London Boulevard and southwest end of Runway 25R.

Airport staff assisted by removing vegetation to provide emergency response personnel access to the aircraft. National Transportation Safety Board (NTSB) responded and, after their initial review, authorized removal of the aircraft.

The pilot, who was the sole occupant on board, reported no injuries. There was minor damage to the blades of the Airport's tractor mower, which is being handled by Public Works Fleet Department.
