SUMMARY

Every April, the Livermore Public Library hosts an annual Teen Art Expo featuring art created by students from the City of Livermore. Each year, the Commission for the Arts is asked to provide three judges who help determine the overall winners of the expo. The artwork will be fully displayed in early April, and the judges are asked to make their decisions between April 2 and April 12.

DISCUSSION
