SUBJECT: Resolution authorizing the execution of the second amendment to an agreement with

Flock Safety, Inc. for the License Plate Reader (LPR) camera expansion, increasing the

amount not-to-exceed \$815,000.

RECOMMENDED ACTION

Staff recommends that the City Council adopt a resolution authorizing the City Manager to execute the second amendment to an agreement with Flock Safety, Inc. for an additional 40 License Plate Reader (LPR) cameras and software subscription within the City of Livermore to replace the existing Motorola Vigilant LPR cameras in an amount not-to-exceed \$815,000.

SUMMARY

Staff recommends the purchase, delivery, and installation of 40 replacement LPR cameras from Flock Safety, Inc. The current Motorola Vigilant LPR cameras are at the end of their life and need replacement. This second agreement amendment will add an additional 40 cameras to the existing 20 Flock camera agreement, which includes all software subscriptions to operate the camera system and perform investigative analysis, for an additional \$594,037 on top of the original agreement of \$218,600.

DISCUSSION

The Livermore Police Department has used License Plate Reader (LPR) cameras since 2014. The current LPRs have reached their end of life and need to be replaced. Flock Safety has performed a site assessment and concluded that 40 LPR cameras can replace the 79 existing cameras due to advancements in camera technology and lane span. This second agreement amendment will add an additional 40 cameras to the existing 20 Flock cameras agreement, which includes all software subscriptions to operate the camera system and perform investigative analysis.

FISCAL AND ADMINISTRATIVE IMPACTS

The Police Department's approved budget for FY 2024-25 has sufficient funds for the purchase, installation, and subscription costs of the additional Flock cameras, which total \$131,849 for the first
