TITLE: Interlocal Agreement: Sewer Pump Station #12 Bypass to Mountlake Terrace

SUMMARY:

The attached agreement establishes the terms of use for diverting sewer from Lynnwood Pump Station #12 into Mountlake Terrace's sewer system.

BACKGROUND:

Sewer Pump Station #12 is located at 7000 216th St SW, in the southwest corner of the City. While we have some redundancies built into the station, occasionally we need to take the station off-line for maintenance or emergencies. When that happens, we divert the sewer into Mountlake Terrace's sewer system. That bypass connection, and our collaborative partnership with Mountlake Terrace has existed since 1977.

The previous agreement between our two agencies was signed in 1982. The attached agreement updates the terms and conditions of this use.

Lynnwood Public Works would like to recognize, and extend our appreciation for Mountlake Terrace's continued support for this bypass. Regional inter-agency collaboration such as this is critical for efficiently operating a complex system. Our longstanding relationship is a strong one, and we hope to continue to find ways to assist each other well into the future.

SUGGESTED ACTION:

Authorize the Mayor to sign and execute an interlocal agreement with Mountlake Terrace allowing for sewer bypass at Lynnwood Sewer Pump Station #12.

PREVIOUS COUNCIL ACTIONS:

Previous agreement was adopted and executed on May 10th, 1982.

FUNDING:

Lynnwood will pay Mountlake Terrace \$5.22 per CCF (100 cubic feet, or 748 gallons) of sewer diverted into their system. Charges will only occur when diversions are made. All charges will be paid from the Sewer Utility (Fund 411).

This will no financial impact on the City's General Fund.

VISIONS AND PRIORITIES ALIGNMENT:

The City of Lynnwood (City) owns and operates a wastewater utility, which include gravity sewers, sewer force mains, lift stations and a Wastewater Treatment Plant (WWTP). This agreement allows us operate our utility without disruption to our customers in case of emergency or necessary maintenance.
