Approval of Advertising a Notice of Intent to Amend the Student Progression Plan, and Setting a Public Hearing on the Proposed Amendments at the Board Meeting Scheduled for July 29, 2025 (General Fund)

Executive Summary

The School Board annually approves the School District of Manatee County Student Progression Plan, which defines the criteria for graduation, promotion, intensive remediation, course offerings, evaluating student performance, and reporting to students and parents. The Student Progression Plan for Manatee County has been developed based on Florida Statutes and current and local needs. The attached revisions and change log document the District's annual updates to Student Progression, Elementary School, Middle School, High School and K-12 - Virtual Education. Approving the advertising and setting of a Public Hearing assures compliance with the provisions of Section 120.54 (3) (a) 1, Florida Statutes.
