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**SUBJECT:** Contract No. SP545-22 Law Enforcement Services for Metrolink - Exercise Option 2 and Increase Contract Authority - Los Angeles County Sheriff's Department

### **Issue**

Additional contract authority is necessary to continue law enforcement services through June 30, 2027. This contract extension is requested to ensure continuity of operations through the upcoming 2026 FIFA World Cup. The LASD Metrolink Bureau is leading the efforts in coordinating law enforcement response for this event.

### **Recommendation**

It is recommended the Board authorize the Chief Executive Officer to amend Contract No. SP545-22 with the Los Angeles County Sheriff's Department (LASD) for Law Enforcement Services to exercise Option 2 through June 30, 2027, and increase the contract authority in the amount of \$4,333,986 for FY27. This will increase the total contract authority from \$53,816,490 to \$58,150,476.

### **Strategic Commitment**

This report aligns with the Strategic Business Plan commitment of:

- **Safety is Foundational:** We will stay on leading edge by deploying new technologies and processes to enhance the safety and security of our riders, our fellow employees, and the communities we serve. Law enforcement and private security services provide safety and security to the Metrolink commuter rail system during regular service as well as during high profile events, such as the 2026 World Cup events.

## **Background**

Through Contract No. SP545-22 LASD provides law enforcement services for all trains, platforms and facilities within Metrolink's operating territory. LASD is responsible for fare enforcement, right-of-way enforcements/trespassing, grade-crossing enforcements, and serving as a liaison with local police jurisdictions.

## **Discussion**

The Authority entered into an agreement with LASD for Law Enforcement Services on April 22, 2022, with a contract authority of \$53,816,490 for a term from July 1, 2022, through June 30, 2025, with two one-year option periods.

On October 27, 2022, under Amendment No. 1 the Scope of Work and Price Proposal was revised for FY23.

On July 1, 2025, the Authority amended the Agreement under Amendment No. 2 to exercise the first one-year option.

The Authority now desires to amend the contract under Amendment No. 3, effective July 1, 2026, to exercise the second and final one-year option by revising Article 2 - Period of Performance, to extend the term through June 30, 2027, and to increase the contract authority an additional \$ 4,333,986 to cover anticipated costs for FY27, revising the total contract authority from \$53,816,490 to \$58,150,476.

## **Budget Impact**

The amounts for which contract authority is requested are included in, and are contingent upon, the adoption of the Proposed FY27 Operating Budget.

## **Next Steps**

Upon Board approval, the Chief Executive Officer will execute Contract No. SP545-22 Amendment No. 3 with the Los Angeles County Sheriff's Department to extend the period of performance through June 30, 2027, and increase contract authority amount not-to-exceed \$58,150,476.
