Summary

The Stockman Park play structure is scheduled for replacement in 2026. The Stockman Park neighborhood participated in a pre-engagement survey in October 2025 to advocate for play structures they would like to see and color options. The city used the communities' results from the pre-engagement survey for the play structure proposals. The Stockman Park neighborhood participated in a public meeting on May 7, 2026 with the optional website survey to select one of four proposal submissions. After review of the four play structures options, the Stockman Park neighborhood selected the MWP Recreation proposal in the neutral color palette. The community voted on a Brown, Dark Green, Forest Green color option. This color combination matches closely with the Forester color template. All equipment conforms to ADA and Consumer Product Safety Commission guidelines. The total expense for the play structure is \$95,000.00. Installation of the new play structure equipment is to take place on or before September 1, 2026. Staff recommends the purchase of the MWP Recreation play structure including installation, as selected by the Stockman Park neighborhood.

Financial or Budget Considerations

The 2026-2035 Capital Improvement Program Park Section includes \$95,000.00 for new playground equipment.

Legal Considerations

Agreement for Local Improvement has been reviewed and approved by the City Attorney.

Equity Considerations

Providing unbiased programs and services through infrastructure that supports and advances diversity, equity, and inclusion in all Golden Valley parks.

Recommended Action

Motion to approve contract with MWP Recreation for the purchase and installation of the Stockman Park play structure in the amount of \$95,000.00.
