SUBJECT: AN AMENDMENT TO THE PROFESSIONAL SERVICES AGREEMENT WITH RMA GROUP AND AN AMENDMENT TO THE AGREEMENT WITH KIZH NATION RESOURCES MANAGEMENT FOR THE ONTARIO SPORTS EMPIRE PROJECT

RECOMMENDATION: That the City Council take the following actions:

- A. Authorize the City Manager, or his designee, to execute Amendment No. 6 to the Professional Services Agreement with RMA Group, of Rancho Cucamonga, California, to provide on-call geotechnical consulting, materials testing, and special inspection services for the Ontario Sports Empire project in the amount of \$1,504,150 for a total not-to-exceed contract amount of \$7,147,513; and
- B. Authorize an extension to the Agreement with Kizh Nation Resources Management to monitor all groundwork to ensure that any Native American Cultural Resources are properly mitigated per the approved Environmental Impact Report for the Ontario Sports Empire project in the amount of \$385,805 for a total not-to-exceed contract amount of \$1,386,765.

THE FOLLOWING COUNCIL GOALS ARE BEING ACHIEVED:

Invest in the City's Infrastructure (Water, Streets, Sewers, Parks, Storm Drains and Public Facilities)

Encourage, Provide or Support Enhanced Recreational, Educational, Cultural and Healthy City Programs, Policies and Activities

FISCAL IMPACT: The proposed Amendment No. 6 to the Professional Services Agreement with RMA Group is in the amount of \$1,504,150 for a total not-to-exceed contract amount of \$7,147,513. The Kizh Nation Resources Management agreement extension is in the amount of \$385,805 for a total not-to-exceed contract amount of \$1,386,765. If approved, additional appropriations in the Capital Projects – Measure Q Fund will be included in future quarterly budget updates to the City Council as needed for the Ontario Sports Empire project.

BACKGROUND & ANALYSIS: On October 15, 2024, the City Council approved an amendment to the Professional Services Agreement with RMA Group to provide geotechnical consulting, materials

testing and special inspection services for the Ontario Sports Empire project. Staff recommends approving Amendment No. 6 to the Professional Services Agreement with RMA Group to provide additional geotechnical consulting, compaction testing, fenestration testing, and special inspection services for the Ontario Sports Empire project.

On August 6, 2024, the City Council approved the Environmental Impact Report for the Ontario Sports Empire. On October 10, 2024, the City Council approved an Agreement with Kizh Nation Resources Management for Native American Cultural Resources mitigation for the Professional Baseball Stadium project. If the extension is approved, as recommended, Kizh Nation Resources Management will monitor all groundwork to ensure the Native American Cultural Resources are properly mitigated per the approved Environmental Impact Report for the Ontario Sports Empire project.
