9-1-1 ADVANCED LIFE SUPPORT EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES

Financial Impact:

Expense \$180,000 Fiscal Year 2026-27

Summary:

On July 1, 2020, the Placentia Fire and Life Safety Department began to provide emergency services to the residents of Placentia. In 2025, the City entered into a Professional Services Agreement with Emergency Ambulance Service, Inc. (Emergency) to provide 9-1-1 Advanced Life Support (ALS) services. The initial year has come to a conclusion, and staff is recommending that the City amend the contract for an additional one (1) year term, with the option for two additional one-year terms in order to protect the public health and safety of the community, while the City continues to work toward identifying a long term 9-1-1 / ALS Service plan for the City.

Recommended Action:

It is recommended that the City Council:

1. Approve a First Amendment to Professional Services Agreement with Emergency Ambulance Service, Inc. for the provision of 9-1-1 Advanced Life Support Services for a term of one (1) year in the amount of \$180,000, with the option to extend for two (2) additional one-year terms; and
2. Authorize the Acting City Administrator and/or her designee to execute all necessary documents, in a form approved by the City Attorney.

Strategic Plan Statement:

Strategic Goal No. 2: Public Safety, by providing a safe, family-friendly environment through proactive policing, efficient fire and emergency medical services, disaster preparedness, and strong community partnerships that protect residents, businesses, and visitors.

Discussion:

Emergency Services consist of paramedics who provide advance life support to our city Fire Department by treating and transporting complex medical emergencies. On July 1, 2020, the Placentia Fire and Life Safety Department began to provide emergency services to the residents of Placentia. In 2025, the City entered into a Professional Services Agreement with Emergency Ambulance Service, Inc. (Emergency) to provide 9-1-1 Advanced Life Support

(ALS) services. The initial year has come to a conclusion, and staff is recommending that the City amend the contract for an additional one (1) year term, with the option for two additional one-year terms in order to protect the public health and safety of the community, while the City continues to work toward identifying a long term 9-1-1 / ALS Service plan for the City. Extending the agreement will ensure uninterrupted delivery of high-quality emergency medical response as the City evaluates the most effective and sustainable service model moving forward.

Financial Summary:

Per the proposed amendment, the annual payment to Emergency for these services will be \$180,000 per year. In the event that the contract is extended and/or Emergency Ambulance participates in an RFP process for 9-1-1 Advanced Life Support Services, this amount may be adjusted in future years in accordance with costs incurred, and subject to the negotiations of the parties.
