Procurement:

Due to the sensitive nature of the requested services, the City found it prudent and in its best interest to request competitive quotes from known sources/vendors rather than publicly soliciting for mentioned services. It is for this reason why we are requesting to waive the procurement requirement detailed in section 2-226(b) of the City's code relating to internet posting.
