Summary:

Requesting authorization and approval of the following:

To issue a work authorization/purchase order and process payment(s) to Craven Thompson & Associates, Inc. for Professional Engineering Services (further defined in the attached proposal) associated with the "Lauderhill Water Main Interconnect" project in the amount of \$59,550.91.

Procurement:

The Procurement Department has reviewed the information provided and has determined; that the hourly rates utilized to determine the totals provided in the proposal are in accordance with Agreement No. 015-19; "Continuing Consulting Engineering Services for Wastewater and Water Utilities Engineering within Environmental and Sanitary Disciplines (Scope "B" Local/Regional)" between the City of Plantation and Craven Thompson & Associates, Inc. - (Scope B) Exhibit "C" Billing Rates (see attached latest Amendment).

This continuing agreement (015-19) between the City and Craven Thompson & Associates, Inc, is currently set to expire is set to expire January 16, 2026. In addition, the use of this of this Agreement "continuing contract" for the mentioned work complies with Florida Statute 287.055 as the construction work related to this project is not estimated to exceed 7.5 million dollars.

Based on the forgoing information the Procurement and Utilities Department is requesting for authorization and approval of the following:

Background:

Strategic Priorities: Planning for a Sustainable Future, Proactive and Responsive Asset Management

The existing 6" water main interconnect for Plantation & Lauderhill is undersized and out of date. A new 12" water main interconnect will allow for either City to assist the other in the event of a water distribution emergency.

A grant in the amount of \$181,000.00 has been awarded to the City for this project and is pending contract execution (Risk Management).
