Resolution approving a Master Services Agreement with Nova Southeastern University

Summary:

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF PLANTATION, FLORIDA AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF A MASTER SERVICES AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY AND NOVA SOUTHEASTERN UNIVERSITY FOR THE DEVELOPMENT AND DELIVERY OF VARIOUS PROGRAMS, CONSULTATION SERVICES PLANNING AND RESEARCH SERVICES, AND OTHER RELATED SERVICES FOCUSING ON SMALL BUSINESS DEVELOPMENT, COMMUNITY QUALITY OF LIFE IMPROVEMENT, PUBLIC SERVICE INNOVATION, AND RESEARCH OPPORTUNITIES; AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR OR CHIEF ADMINISTRATIVE OFFICER TO EXECUTE SAME; PROVIDING FINDINGS; PROVIDING A SAVINGS CLAUSE, AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

Background:

Administration is seeking authorization to proceed with execution of the attached Master Services Agreement ("MSA") between the City of Plantation and the Nova Southeastern University, Center for Public Service Innovation and Research. The Center for Public Service Innovation and Research ("CPSIR") is a part of the H. Wayne Huizenga College of Business and Entrepreneurship's Public Administration Program and serves as a hub for applied research, policy development, and training that support municipalities, nonprofits and other public serving organizations. This MSA provides the framework for the City to access NSU's resources to assist with projects, programs, and/or policies in a manner that is flexible and cost effective.

The MSA has a five-year term and provides for project scope and terms to be established through mutually agreed upon "task orders". No costs are incurred until such time as a task order is approved.
