A Resolution to adopt the Proposed Maximum Millage Rates for the City of Plantation Operating Budget & Voted Debt Service for FY2027.

**Summary:**

A RESOLUTION ADOPTING THE PROPOSED OPERATING MAXIMUM MILLAGE RATE OF 5.7000 MILLS AND VOTED DEBT SERVICE MILLAGE RATE OF 0.2637 TO BE LEVIED BY THE CITY OF PLANTATION DURING THE NEXT ENSUING TAX YEAR; ESTABLISHING A TIME AND A PLACE FOR A PUBLIC HEARING TO CONSIDER SUCH PROPOSED MILLAGE AND THE TENTATIVE BUDGET; AND OTHERWISE DIRECTING THE TRANSMITTAL OF CERTAIN INFORMATION TO THE BROWARD COUNTY PROPERTY APPRAISER BY AUGUST 4, 2026 PROVIDING FINDINGS; PROVIDING A SAVINGS CLAUSE; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

**Background:**

State Statute requires taxing authorities to set maximum millage rates and provide this information to the Property Appraiser on or before August 4 each year. The millage rate forwarded to the Property Appraiser is the maximum millage rate that taxing authorities can levy for the next year's budget without going through an expensive mailing process. City Council always has the option of reducing the adopted maximum millage rates (set at the maximum millage meeting) at either of the two Public Budget Hearings scheduled in September.

**Finance Director/Budget Manager Recommendation:**

The maximum millage set this evening will set the maximum millage rates for the City of Plantation FY2027 Operating Budget & Voted Debt Service.

The maximum millage rate for the City of Plantation Operating Budget may be revised only downward at the 1st Public Budget Hearing on September 9, 2026, or the 2nd & Final Budget Hearing on September 16, 2026.

It is recommended that Council adopt the proposed maximum millage rates for the City of Plantation Operating Budget and Voted Debt Service as follows:

City of Plantation Operating Budget – 5.7000 Mills  
Voted Debt Service – 0.2637 Mills
