An Ordinance Creating Sec.26-9 Bulk Water or Wastewater Service

Summary:

Second Reading: AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF PLANTATION, FLORIDA CREATING SECTION 26-9 "BULK WATER OR WASTEWATER SERVICE" OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF PLANTATION; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR CODIFICATION; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICTS; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

Background:

The City of Plantation has received a letter of intent from the City of Lauderhill expressing an interest in a bulk purchase of water from the City of Plantation. In order to facilitate the conversation, Plantation's Code of Ordinances must be updated to provide for the bulk sale regulations that do not currently exist.

The proposed Ordinance would allow the City of Plantation to provide bulk water and wastewater service to counties, other municipalities, other units of government, community development districts, private utilities certified by the public service commission, large industrial facilities, or others. The City of Plantation would retain an absolute discretion in determining whether to provide bulk water or wastewater service. If the City decided to approve another entity's application for bulk service, City Administration would be authorized to negotiate and enter into a bulk service agreement with the applicant.

Bulk water and wastewater service rates will be determined by a study and brought forward for the City Council adoption and inclusion in the Utility Rate Index at the future date, as required by this Ordinance.
