Procurement:

On February 9, 2022, Consent Agenda Item No. 5, the City of Plantation- City Council approved the standardization of the City's Lift Station Pumps to multiple manufacturers listed below.

For Submersible Lift Station Pump(s):

Hydromatic - 2 HP and under
Tsurumi and Barnes - 10 HP and under
Flygt, Wilo, and Keen - all HP and sizes

For Can Style Lift Station Pump(s):

Gorman Rupp

Pursuant to the "Standardization" requirements, the Utilities Department received competitive informal quotes from vendors who represent one of the manufacturers listed in the "Notice of Standardization" for Can Style Lift Station(s) (Crown).
