A Resolution Supporting a City of Plantation REV Grant Application

Summary:

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF PLANTATION, FLORIDA SUPPORTING THE CITY'S APPLICATION FOR FUNDING FROM THE BROWARD METROPOLITAN PLANNING ORGANIZATION ("MPO") ROADS FOR ECONOMIC VITALITY ("REV") GRANT PROGRAM; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICTS; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

Background:

The Broward Metropolitan Planning Organization has recently launched a new grant program, Roads for Economic Vitality, in place of the former Complete Streets Program grant. In this, the first, grant application cycle, the city is requesting funding for the Cypress Roadway Project. This project would provide for a wide variety of improvements to the Cypress Road corridor spanning from NW 70th Avenue to E. Acre Drive. A location map detailing roadway improvements is attached for your convenience, along with a copy of the grant meeting announcement. This document was mailed to residents within 1500 feet of the project, as well as circulated on social media, and copies placed at City facilities in the area (e.g. library, Jim Ward, Community Center and City Hall).

Total project cost is estimated at \$8.7 million, with the City's portion estimated at \$3.2 million. Please note that the estimate project budget provides for inflation as, if awarded, funding would not be available for roughly five (5) years after award.

A public information meeting regarding this application is scheduled for June 9, 2026.
