**Subject:**

Automated License Plate Reader Cameras for Midtown District

**Summary:**

Requesting authorization and approval of the following:

- Execute the First Amendment between the City and Axon Enterprise, Inc for the purchase of Automated License Plate Readers as further outlined in the attached Amendment.
- To process payments to Axon Enterprise, Inc for the services and equipment outlined in the attached Amendment during the initial term (5 years) and any additional renewal terms that may be approved administratively in and accordance with Agreement No. 027-23 and any associated Amendments, and contingent upon budget approval.

**Procurement:**

**Whereas**, on May 8, 2025, the City and Axon Enterprise, Inc. entered into an agreement to provide comprehensive and integrated Body-Worn Cameras (BWC), a Digital Evidence Management System ("System"), and all related accessories and ancillary components as a turnkey solution to capture video from an officer's perspective (Agreement No. 027-23); and

**Whereas**, pursuant to and consistent with Section 2-226(g)(13), the City negotiated the purchase of additional hardware and software not included in the original solicitation in the interest of public safety, in order to create a cohesive ecosystem of connected hardware and software that will enhance safety, efficiency, and accountability for the City; and

**Whereas**, pursuant to and consistent with Section 2-226(g)(13), the City desires to amend the Agreement to include the purchase of Automated License Plate Reader cameras (“ALPRs”), which were not included in the original solicitation, in the interest of public safety, to further support a cohesive and integrated public safety technology ecosystem; and

**Whereas**, in addition to the ALPRs to be purchased for the Midtown District, the City will install an additional thirty (30) ALPRs to be funded by RedSpeed Florida, LLC pursuant to Agreement No. 005-24, Speed Detection Camera System for School Zones – Term Contract. Section 5 (Fees and Payments) of that agreement provides that the fee includes all costs associated with the Speed Photo Enforcement (SPE) system, including but not limited to camera equipment, installation, maintenance, Rekor (or other major brand ALPR provider) licensing and integration, violation processing services, DMV records access, mailing services, payment processing, call center support, public awareness support, and access to a web-based system for enforcement review; and

**Whereas**, for the avoidance of doubt, the City required RedSpeed to execute an amendment clarifying that the foregoing provision establishes that RedSpeed is responsible for all costs associated with camera equipment, installation, maintenance, and ALPR licensing and integration. It is the parties’ intent that this obligation operates on a one-to-one basis, such that for each Speed Detection Camera installed under the Agreement, RedSpeed shall provide and bear all costs associated with one corresponding ALPR unit, including all licensing, integration, maintenance, and operational expenses, at no additional cost to the City; and

**Whereas**, in the event that the agreement between the City and RedSpeed Florida, LLC is terminated for any reason, the City shall be financially responsible for the continued operation and funding of the ALPR units should the City elect to continue the program;

Now, therefore, based on the foregoing, the Administration, Police Department, and Procurement Department request authorization and approval of the following:

- Execute the First Amendment between the City and Axon Enterprise, Inc for the purchase of Automated License Plate Readers as further outlined in the attached Amendment.
- To process payments to Axon Enterprise, Inc for the services and equipment outlined in the attached Amendment during the initial term (5 years) and any additional renewal terms that may be approved administratively in and accordance with Agreement No. 027-23 and any associated Amendments, and contingent upon budget approval.

**Background:**

**Strategic Priority: Safe and Secure.**

Expanding the Plantation Police Department's Automated License Plate Recognition (ALPR) program will enhance public safety while supporting more effective investigations. ALPR technology helps officers quickly identify stolen vehicles, missing persons, and vehicles associated with serious crimes, allowing for faster responses and improved coordination with neighboring agencies.

Axon ALPRs seamlessly integrate into the Police Department's existing Axon technology ecosystem, allowing officers and investigators to access critical information through systems they already use, improving efficiency and accountability. By expanding this program, Plantation can strengthen neighborhood security, deter criminal activity, and provide investigators with critical leads that help solve crimes more efficiently-ultimately making our community safer for residents, families, and visitors.

This item is now ready for City Council consideration.
