Resolution confirming the City of Plantation's acceptance and willingness to service a dependent special district

Summary:

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PLANTATION, FLORIDA CONFIRMING THE CITY'S ACCEPTANCE AND WILLINGNESS TO OPERATE A DEPENDENT SPECIAL DISTRICT TO PROVIDE SERVICE TO THE AREA FORMERLY KNOWN AS THE PLANTATION ACRES IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICTS; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

Background:

In February 2025, the Board of Supervisors of the Plantation Acres Improvement District (PAID) voted 4-1 to voluntarily dissolve. The Resolution provided confirms the City of Plantation's acceptance and willingness to service this area as a dependent special district, should this be in accordance with the wishes of the district residents as expressed in a referendum. Additionally, this resolution directs City Administration and the City Attorney to take the necessary steps to submit a local bill to facilitate this change.

A copy of the draft bill has been transmitted to the PAID Chairman and Chief Administrative Officer Jason Nunemaker will be in attendance at their September 15th meeting for discussion of the bill.
