Subject:

Appointment of member to the Plantation Police Officers' Retirement Fund Board of Trustees for a four (4) year term.

Summary:

Background:

The current representative appointed is Councilmember Denise Horland who wishes to continue serving.

Sec. 18-66. - The board of trustees.

(a)Membership. There is hereby created a board of trustees of the said police officers retirement system for the city which shall serve as the trustee of the police officers fund; in addition, the general administration, management and responsibility of the proper operation of the police officers retirement system shall be vested solely in said board of trustees. The board shall consist of five (5) member trustees as follows:

(1)Two (2) legal residents of the city appointed by the city council;(2)Two (2) police officer members of the plan who are elected by a majority of the police officers who are members of the plan, as hereinafter provided; and(3)A fifth person chosen by a majority of the previous four (4) members of the board of trustees. The name of the fifth person shall be submitted to the city council which shall, as a ministerial duty, appoint him to the board.

(b)Term; oath of office.

(1)Each resident member shall serve for a period of four (4) years, unless sooner replaced by the city council at whose pleasure he or she shall serve, and may succeed himself or herself in office.

Each member elected by other members of the system shall serve for a period of four (4) years, unless he or she sooner leaves the employment of the city as a police officer,

whereupon the city council shall choose his or her successor in the same manner as an original appointment.

The fifth member chosen by a majority of the other four (4) members of the board shall also serve for a period of four (4) years and may succeed himself/herself in office.

(2)Each police officer member may succeed himself in office. The fifth member of the board shall have the same rights as each of the other four (4) members and may succeed himself in office. Each trustee shall take an oath of office to be administered by the city clerk or a notary public.
