A Resolution of the City of Plantation Accepting a Safe Streets for all Grant

Summary:

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PLANTATION, FLORIDA ACCEPTING A SAFE STREETS FOR ALL GRANT AND AUTHORIZING ADMINISTRATION TO TAKE ALL NECESSARY STEPS TO SECURE THE FUNDING; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICTS; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

Background:

In 2023 the City Council of the City of Plantation formally adopted the Multi-Modal Master Transportation Plan ("Plan"). This Plan identified crash clusters primarily on City owned roadways and proposed solutions to minimize these hazards. The Plan identified nine (9) projects, three (3) of which were proposed for funding by a Safe Streets for All ("SS4") planning and demonstration grant. The grant, in the amount of \$2 million (\$1.4 million Federal funds and \$400,000 City match) fund planning and construction of temporary improvements as outlined in the MMTP. If the projects are successful at minimizing crashes, the City could then apply for permanent construction funding. The Resolution provided authorizes Administration to accept the funding and to take all steps required to secure this funding.

Copies of the applicable portions of the MMTP are attached for your reference.
