Purchase of 2027 Osage Super Warrior

Summary:

Request for authorization and approval of the following:

Authorization and approval of a competitive procurement exemption pursuant to section 2-226(g)(5) of the City's code, and utilization of the pricing/costing structure identified in Florida Sheriff's Association Contract No. FSA25-VEF19.0 (Fire & Rescue Vehicles, Boats & Equipment).

Authorization and approval to issue a purchase order and process a payment(s) to Ten-8 Fire & Safety for a 2027 Osage Super Warrior (further detailed in the attached Quote and Proposal) for the amount of \$542,246.00.

Procurement:

Notwithstanding the obvious benefit served by having all purchases submitted to competitive procurement, circumstances can arise when the City determines there is no need for the City to seek competitive procurement. In such cases the City shall seek a waiver of the competitive procurement process. The Procurement and Fire Department is requesting approval of a "competitive procurement exemption/wavier" pursuant to Sec. 2-226(g)(5) of the City's Code.

The Plantation Fire Department is requesting the use of Florida Sheriff's Association Contract No. FSA25-VEF19.0 to purchase a new 2027 Osage Super Warrior. Florida Sheriff's Association Contract No. FSA25-VEF19.0 (Fire & Rescue Vehicles, Boats & Equipment) complies with our City Code regarding aforementioned competitive procurement exemption. Florida Sheriffs Association Contract is set to expire March 31, 2027.

Based on the foregoing, the Procurement and Fire Department request authorization and approval of the following:

- Authorization and approval of a competitive procurement exemption pursuant to section 2-226(g)(5) of the City's code, and utilization of the pricing/costing structure identified in Florida Sheriff's Association Contract No. FSA25-VEF19.0 (Fire & Rescue Vehicles, Boats & Equipment).
- Authorization and approval to issue a purchase order and process a payment(s) to Ten-8 Fire & Safety for a 2027 Osage Super Warrior (further detailed in the attached Quote and Proposal) for the amount of \$542,246.00.

Background:

Strategic Priorities; Planning for a Sustainable Future, Proactive and Responsive Asset Management

The vehicle is relied upon for critical emergency operations including technical rescue incidents, fire suppression support, specialized equipment transport, and incident command functions. Any unexpected breakdown or out-of-service condition directly impacts the department's ability to provide timely and effective emergency response to the community.

The acquisition and deployment of this item is to replace the department's 2005 Rescue Truck with a new rescue apparatus to ensure operational reliability, firefighter safety, and continued emergency response capability. The current 2005 Rescue Truck with 176,313 miles has exceeded its recommended front-line service life. According to industry standards, including recommendations from the National Fire Protection Association, fire apparatus should typically be considered for replacement after approximately 15-20 years of front-line service. At over 20 years old, this vehicle has experienced increasing mechanical failures, rising maintenance costs, and difficulty obtaining replacement parts due to the age of the chassis and components.

This item is now ready for City Council consideration.
