**Summary:**

Request for authorization and approval of the following:

To issue a work authorization/purchase order and process payment(s) to Hazen and Sawyer, P.C. for professional engineering services associated with "Central WTP Injection Well MIT - Professional Engineering Services" project, as further described in the attached proposal for a total amount of \$50,839.40.

**Procurement:**

The Procurement Department has reviewed this information and has determined based on the information provided; that the hourly rates utilized to determine the total provided in the attached quote/proposal are in accordance with Agreement No. 065-22; Wastewater and Water Utilities Engineering with Environmental and Sanitary Disciplines between the City and Hazen and Sawyer P.C.

This continuing services agreement (065-22) between the City and Hazen and Sawyer, P.C. is currently set to expire February 16, 2027. In addition, the use of this "continuing contract" for the mentioned work complies with Florida Statutes 287.055(g), as the proposed construction work is estimated (good faith) not to exceed 7.5 million dollars, as stated by the Utilities Department.

Based on the foregoing Utilities and Procurement Departments is requesting authorization and approval of the following:

**Background:**

**Strategic Priorities: Planning for a Sustainable Future**

The City operates an industrial-type Class I Injection Well at the Central Water Plant. Demonstration of the mechanical integrity of each well must be performed at least once every five years in accordance with the requirements of Rule 62-528 of the Florida Administrative Code. Based on the previous Mechanical Integrity Testing (MIT) the City must complete the next MIT prior to February 18, 2027.

Utilities seeks approval to utilize the engineering services of Hazen & Sawyer for the development of a testing program in a format acceptable to FDEP. Services will include procurement assistance, field observation during testing performance, review & evaluation of testing procedure results, monitoring well water quality testing results & preparation of the MIT report for submittal to FDEP.

This item is now ready for City Council consideration.
