**Subject:**

CWTP Injection Well Operating Permit - Professional Engineering Services.

**Summary:**

Request for authorization and approval of the following:

To issue a work authorization/purchase order and process payment(s) to Hazen and Sawyer, P.C. for professional engineering services associated with "CWTP Injection Well Operating Permit" project, as further described in the attached proposal for a total amount of \$52,559.96.

**Procurement:**

The Procurement Department has reviewed this information and has determined based on the information provided; that the hourly rates utilized to determine the total provided in the attached quote/proposal are in accordance with Agreement No. 065-22; Wastewater and Water Utilities Engineering with Environmental and Sanitary Disciplines between the City and Hazen and Sawyer P.C.

This continuing services agreement (083-24) between the City and Hazen and Sawyer, P.C. is currently set to expire February 16, 2027. In addition, the use of this of this Agreement "continuing contract" for the mentioned work complies with Florida Statute 287.055(g) as the proposed work is considered a "Study activity" and does not exceed \$500,000.00.

Based on the foregoing Utilities and Procurement Departments is requesting for authorization and approval of the following:

**Background:**

**Strategic Priorities: Proactive and Responsive Asset Management**

The City operates a Class I Injection Well at the Central Water Treatment Plant for the disposal of effluent. This operation is currently regulated by FDEP permit. The City is required to apply for a new operating permit prior to 8/17/26 in preparation for the current Underground Injection Control (UIC) operating permit expiration, 10/18/26.

Utilities seeks approval to utilize the engineering services of Hazen & Sawyer to prepare the permit application & supporting documentation in order to meet the application deadline.

This item is now ready for City Council consideration.
