**Subject:**

Purchase of two (2) Complete Drive Roller Assemblies

**Summary:**

Request for authorization and approval of the following:

- Authorization and approval of a competitive procurement exemption pursuant to Sec. 2-226(g)(3) of the City's code.
- Authorization and approval to issue a purchase and process payment(s) to Alfa Laval Inc. for two (2) "Ashbrook Simon Hartley Equipment - Complete Drive Roller Assemblies" (see attached quote) for a total amount of \$41,091.13.

**Procurement:**

Notwithstanding the obvious benefit and public interest served by having all purchases submitted to competitive procurement, circumstances can arise when the city may determine that there is no need for the city to seek competitive procurement.

On February 21, 2024, the City of Plantation publicly posted an "Intent to Sole/single Source" (ISS No. 064-24) in reference to Florida Statute 287.057(3)(C) for the purchase of Ashbrook Simon Hartley equipment (Genuine Parts and Accessories). This was publicly advertised for fifteen (15) calendar days, broadcasted to 944 Suppliers and had 6 Planholders. The City received no responses/written statements from other possible suppliers indicating they could provide parts., service, and accessories that meets or exceeds the specifications provided in the Intent to Sole/Single Source.

The mentioned sole/single source is currently set to expire on March 7, 2027.

Based on the forgoing, Procurement and Utilities Departments requests authorization and approval of the following:

- Authorization and approval of a competitive procurement exemption pursuant to Sec. 2-

- Authorization and approval to issue a purchase and process payment(s) to Alfa Laval Inc. for two (2) "Ashbrook Simon Hartley Equipment - Complete Drive Roller Assemblies" (see attached quote) for a total amount of \$41,091.13.

**Background:**

**Strategic Priorities: Planning for a Sustainable Future, Proactive and Responsive Asset Management**

The Regional Wastewater Plant operates (3) Ashbrook Belt Presses, each equipped with (2) drive roller assemblies. The roller assemblies allow the belts to progress through the filtration cycle, compressing the liquids from the solids in the sludge. The rollers on press #3 are no longer cost effective to repair and must be replaced.

This item is now ready for City Council consideration.
