Summary:

Requesting authorization and approval of the following:

Issue a work authorization/purchase order and process payment(s) to Kimley-Horn and Associates, Inc., for Traffic and Transportation Engineering Services relating to "Conceptual Design Project of SW 80th Terrace" as further described in the attached proposal for a total amount of \$66,585.00.

Procurement:

The Procurement Department has reviewed information/documentation provided by the Engineering Department and has concluded based on the information provided; that the rates utilized to determine the total provided in the attached proposal are in accordance with Agreement No. 083-24; Continuing Services Agreement for Traffic and Transportation Engineering between the City and Kimley-Horn and Associates, Inc.

This continuing services agreement (083-24) between the City and Kimley-Horn and Associates, Inc. is currently set to expire February 28, 2028. In addition, the use of this of this Agreement "continuing contract" for the mentioned work complies with Florida Statute 287.055 as the proposed construction is estimated not to exceed 7.5 million dollars (as stated by the Engineering Department), and if categorized as a "Study Activity" the monetary value of the engineering work does not exceed \$500,000.00.

Based on the foregoing information, the Procurement and Engineering Departments requests authorization and approval of the following:

- Issue a work authorization/purchase order and process payment(s) to Kimley-Horn and Associates, Inc., for Traffic and Transportation Engineering Services relating to

"Conceptual Design Project of SW 80th Terrace" as further described in the attached proposal for a total amount of \$66,585.00.

Background:

Strategic Priorities: Planning for Sustainable Future; Proactive and Responsive Asset Management; Balance Progress w/Traditions.

The purpose of this project is to establish a critical internal vehicular and pedestrian connection within Midtown. With the cooperation of the property owners, the intent is to convert the existing private connection between Peters Road and SW 10th Street to public access and redesign it as needed. The scope of work includes survey, traffic study, conceptual design alternatives, and a public meeting with the Midtown Advisory Board and City Council.
