### **Action Requested:**

Considering a Council Initiated Action (CIA) requesting that City Council allocate \$100,000 from the Contingency Fund to supplement the costs of Channel One to supply food and formula to residents who may lose federal benefits in November 2025.

## Report Narrative:

Council Member Dan Doering brings forward this Council Initiated Action for consideration, with Council Member Norman Wahl supporting as the second, as required by the Council Rules of Procedure Ch. 2 - Internal Council Conduct, Sec 2.03 - Placing Items on the Business Meeting Agenda, subd. B. This request is as follows: "Authorization to allocate \$100,000 from Contingency Fund to supplement the costs of Channel One to supply food and formula to residents who may lose federal benefits in November 2025." A Council Initiated Action (CIA) allows the Council to discuss and determine whether to advance the work as a priority for staff and other resources. Approval of this CIA would not finalize a project or allocate funds but would direct staff to prioritize research and planning efforts and return to Council with recommendations. If the CIA is not approved, the work may still be considered through other planning mechanisms, though not with the same prioritization or timeline.

#### Notes:

- This item meets the eligibility criteria for the Continency Fund. As of October 27, 2025, the balance of the contingency fund is \$627,606.69.
- A draft service agreement is attached to illustrate the type of agreement that would be executed for the requested services at a future meeting. The draft outlines that funding may be distributed in installments and would only be released if a federal government shutdown is in a effect.
