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**Recommendation:**

Adopt a Resolution of the City Council of the City of Rocklin Acknowledging the Fire Department's Compliance with Sections 13146.2 and 13146.3 of the California Health and Safety Code.

**Background:**

On September 27, 2018, California Senate Bill 1205 (SB1205) became effective, and added a new section to the California Health and Safety Code, affecting every fire department and fire district in the State. SB1205 requires every fire department or district providing fire protection services to inspect all public and private schools, hotels, motels, lodging houses, and apartment buildings annually. Fire departments and fire districts shall report their compliance to Sections 13146.2 and 13146.3 of the Health and Safety Code annually to their administering authority.

The Rocklin Fire Department conducted inspections of 37 Group E Occupancies (public and private schools) and 56 Group R Occupancies (hotels, motels, lodging, etc.) during the 2023/24 Fiscal Year, as identified in Exhibits A and B to the resolution.
