Recommendation:

- A. Conduct a Public Hearing to Consider Testimony.
- B. Introduce, Waive the Full Reading and Read by Title Only, an Ordinance of the City Council of the City of Rocklin Approving and Adopting a Military Equipment Use Policy for Fiscal Year 2023/24.

Background:

Assembly Bill 481 requires an ordinance for a law enforcement agency to adopt a policy for use of military equipment prior to purchasing, raising funds, acquiring, using and/or collaborating with other law enforcement agencies in the deployment or use of military equipment within the governing body's jurisdiction. On June 28, 2022, the City Council adopted Ordinance 1150, adopting a military equipment policy authorizing use of all military equipment outlined in the Rocklin Police Department (RPD) inventory report. In order to adhere to the policy, as well as AB 481, an annual report must be submitted to the governing body with any updates relevant to the policy at a public meeting.

Fiscal Impact:

There is no direct fiscal impact to the General Fund from the staff recommendation.
