Recommendation:

Adopt a Resolution of the City Council of the City of Rocklin Approving and Authorizing the Purchase of Four Chevrolet Tahoe Police Vehicles from Winner Chevrolet and Authorizing the City Manager to Purchase the Vehicles from Winner Chevrolet.

Background:

Included in the Fiscal Year (FY) 2023/24 Operating Budget, approved by the City Council on June 27, 2023 (Resolution No. 2023-109), was the purchase of four (4) new marked patrol units.

Rocklin Municipal Code Section 3.04.090(C) authorizes the City to enter into cooperative purchasing arrangements with other governmental entities without separate competitive bidding. The state's program provides local government agencies access to competitively bid and publicly solicited contracts from vendors who supply goods and services. These contracts are created through a competitive bid process that allows members to "piggyback" on the competitive bid contract, eliminating the need to complete the individual RFP/bid process and allowing the City to move quickly to secure services/equipment.

Pursuant to the state contract, Winner Chevrolet Inc. (Elk Grove) has issued quotes for the vehicles noted above (Attachment 1) for a total amount of \$245,599 (rounded). Staff recommends the City Council authorize the purchase of the vehicles from Winner Chevrolet in an amount not to exceed \$245,599 (rounded), pursuant to California Contract No. 1-22-23-23D (Attachment 2).

Fiscal Impact:

No additional fiscal impact has been identified as the amounts noted in this request are included in the FY 2023/24 Operating Budget.
