**Recommendation:**

Adopt a Resolution of the City Council of the City of Rocklin Approving and Authorizing the City Manager to Execute a Reimbursement Agreement with the Rocklin Unified School District for School Resource Officers.

**Background:**

For more than twenty years, the City of Rocklin Police Department has been providing up to three School Resource Officers (SRO) to the Rocklin Unified School District (RUSD), two sworn police officers at the high school level and more recently one sworn police officer at RUSD middle school campuses.

This one-year contract continues the partnership between the City and RUSD with three sworn police officers to assist RUSD with its goal of providing a safe and secure learning environment on RUSD campuses, under the same terms as previous years' contracts. RUSD will continue to reimburse the City fifty percent (50%) of the costs of wages, mandatory benefits, and health benefits of the SROs assigned to RUSD schools for the term of this contract.

**Fiscal Impact:**

The amount reimbursed will vary based on the actual cost of officers assigned to RUSD. There is no additional fiscal impact to the General Fund from the staff recommendation. The remaining costs are included in the Fiscal Year 2025/26 budget appropriations.
