**BACKGROUND:** Per our Capital Outlay I have requested to replace an old van that will be traded in and replace it with a new 2024 GMC 2500 as well as purchase a new 2024 GMC 1500 for the Utility Director position. This will ensure that we have the correct number of vehicles for the number of workers we have and purchasing a Utility Director truck is vital for me to do work in the field as well as provide a redundant vehicle in case something happens to one of the other trucks.

In Utilites, having 1 truck per person is standard, especially for such a small outfit as ours. The Scio Township Utilites budget is stout and can accommodate such a necessary request. Our vehicles appearance and condition are of extreme importance to the public as it reflects the professionalism and dependability that they deserve.

Lafontain of Ann Arbor offered \$1500 trade in for our old ford van that isn't being used.

\*\*\*\*Both vehicles were sought out by using MI DEAL pricing which is competitive bidding process and will both receive a GM Municiple Discount.
