**DISCUSSION:**

The consultant for the Space Coast TPO, Travis Hills, with Kittelson & Associates will provide a presentation on the TPO's Vision Zero Action Plan, high injury network, and recent successes.

The TPO Governing Board first adopted a Vision Zero resolution in 2019, and staff was given direction to develop an Action Plan. An update to the High Injury Network was made in 2024. To effectively reduce traffic fatalities and serious injuries, a detailed analysis of the high-injury network is essential. Local partnerships, community education, and re-engineering when necessary are key elements of Vision Zero collaboration. Ultimately, leadership is the road to zero.

2,744 people died or were seriously injured on Brevard County roads from 2018 to 2022. To put that number into perspective, one cruise ship can carry around 3,000 people.
