TITLE: TR13912 - A Resolution of the City Commission of the City

of Tamarac, Florida adopting a Resolution of Support for three Municipal Capital Projects for the Broward County Mobility Advancement Program (30-Year One Percent Surtax For Transportation) funding; acknowledging that the projects are located within the City of Tamarac; authorizing the appropriate City officials to take any and all actions necessary to apply and receive the funding for three Municipal Capital Projects in an amount not to exceed \$3,353,459; providing for conflicts; providing for severability;

BACKGROUND:

The Second Amendment to and Restatement of the Transportation System Surtax Interlocal Agreement (ILA) outlines the municipal project eligibility criteria and provides for an annual new MCP application, evaluation and ranking processes, among other terms and conditions. Per the ILA, municipalities seeking transportation funding for new MCPs must submit applications to the Broward Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) consistent with the MPO's prescribed application process. The MPO must open the annual application period no later than April 1st of each year and provide the ranked list of MCPs it recommends for funding in the next fiscal year to the County by June 1st. Ranked MCPs are submitted to the County for final eligibility

approval. Once approved, ranked New MCPs become eligible for funding and inclusion in the County's Five-Year Capital Improvement Plan. Each MCP, including subsequent phases, is re-evaluated on an annual basis.

The application window to submit new MCPs started on February 10th, 2023, and closed on March 10 of the same year. The City submitted three (3) MCPs for consideration during this round of applications:

- NW 94th AVE Traffic Calming (raised school crosswalks) and Roadway Improvement Project
- Sands Point Shuttle Stop No. 04
- Woodlands Boulevard Complete Streets and Traffic Calming Project

The application process requires a Resolution of Support be provided by April 1, 2023, for projects to be considered for this round of funding. The attached Resolution is presented for the City Commission for approval to comply with this requirement.

ISSUE:

The City of Tamarac submitted three (3) Municipal Capital Projects (MCPs) for transportation surtax funding in the estimated amount of \$3,353,459. For Tamarac's MCPs to be considered to receive the Broward County Mobility Advancement program (30-year one percent surtax for transportation) funding, the City is required to provide a Resolution of Support by April 1, 2023.
