MOTION TO APPROVE HENNEPIN COUNTY AGREEMENT #PW 29-06-23 FOR DAKOTA RAIL REGIONAL TRAIL CROSSING IMPROVEMENTS ON COUNTY STATE AID HIGHWAY 15 IN THE CITY OF MOUND.

Background:

Hennepin County, the City of Mound and Three Rivers Park District staff have been working together to design desired improvements to the Dakota Rail Regional Trail crossing of County State Aid Highway (CSAH) 15 in Mound. The trail crossing improvements component is part of a larger County road project and the City's Auditor Road project. The design calls for reducing the number of lanes on CSAH 15 (also known as Shoreline Drive), removal of the Auditor Road intersection adjacent to the trail crossing, creation of a safety refuge for the trail crossing, and addition of Rapid Flashing Beacon technology.

The Agreement identifies a three-way cost share of the total costs related to the regional trail crossing improvements. The current engineer's estimate identifies Three Rivers' funding obligation at \$158,998.03, though this may be higher or lower when the project is fully bid out. Three Rivers has budgeted \$185,000 for the project through its 2024 Asset Managment Program.

The project is scheduled for completion in early summer 2025.
