SUBJECT: Consider approval to donate one complete set of hydraulic powered extrication equipment to the Weatherford College Fire Academy for training purposes.

BACKGROUND/DISCUSSION

The Weatherford Fire Department no longer uses extrication tools that are powered by a gas powerplant that operates hydraulic extrication tools. The Fire Department over the past three years has converted all front line extrication tools to battery powered equipment. The gas powered equipment is no longer utilized and is currently kept in storage. The Weatherford College Fire Academy is in need of extrication equipment. They would use the equipment to teach students in the fire academy about extrication. Donating the tools will be of great benefit to the Weatherford College program.

The set of Extrication equipment is 17 years old and includes the following items:

One Power Plant / Serial Number BT652221

One Ram / Serial Number TR1723

One Cutter / Serial Number SLC271254

One Spreader / Serial Number SL321031

Two Hydraulic Hoses

Used value is \$2,000 to \$4000.00.

FINANCIAL IMPACT

Revenue from the extrication equipment, if sold, could be between \$2,000 and \$4,000.
