SUBJECT: Consider approval to purchase six 2023 Chevrolet Tahoe police patrol vehicles in an amount not to exceed \$216,720 from Caldwell Country Chevrolet through the Tarrant County Cooperative competitive bid contract #2020-174.

BACKGROUND/DISCUSSION

The General Motors nationwide fleet pre-ordering for FY2023 police vehicles opens on May 23, 2022 and must include a purchase order to reserve vehicles. In addition, during the previous two ordering cycles, General Motors has limited pre-ordering to one week and capped the total number of police fleet vehicles. The practice prevents organizations from acquiring vehicles if they were not on the initial pre-order list. Finally, orders may be cancelled before delivery, but they may not be reserved after the pre-order period. Delivery for the vehicles is expected after October 1, 2022.

The Police Department is scheduled an allotment for six vehicles and upfitting from the City's Fleet Vehicle Replacement Fund if approved by the City Council with the FY23 budget adoption.

FINANCIAL IMPACT

The \$216,720 purchase amount is consistent with the scheduled FY2023 allotment from the Fleet Vehicle Replacement Fund pending Council's adoption of the FY23 budget.

SUGGESTED ACTION

Staff recommends approval of the purchase not to exceed \$216,720.
