### BACKGROUND/DISCUSSION

The applicant is requesting approval of a final plat for 42 residential lots. A prior final plat for Phase 4 was approved by City Council on October 25, 2022. Since then, the final plat for Phase 4, as well as the original preliminary plat, have expired. The property owners have now resubmitted a preliminary plat along with a final plat for Phases 3 and 4 for consideration.

All comments previously presented during Planning & Zoning have been addressed.

**ALTERNATIVES**

1. The City Council may approve the plat as proposed.
2. The City Council may approve the plat subject to conditions.
3. The City Council may disapprove the plat for specified reasons.

**SUGGESTED ACTION/RECOMMENDATION**

Staff recommends approval of the final plat subject to all requirements of the Subdivision Ordinance and the attached conditions. At their October 8, 2025, regularly scheduled meeting, the Planning & Zoning Commission voted (6-0) to recommend approval.
