SUBJECT: Consider adoption of Resolution R2022-11 amending the City of Weatherford Neighborhood Traffic Calming Program.

BACKGROUND/DISCUSSION

City staff and the Transportation Advisory Board (TAB) held a work session on February 10, 2022 to discuss updating the City's Neighborhood Traffic Calming Program (NTCP). City staff and our consultant, Kimley-Horn & Associates, discussed the addition of improved criteria to the NTCP along with a formal traffic engineer review to document findings, opinion, and provide any appropriate recommendations. This process will streamline the traffic calming program and provide staff more time to focus on implementation. The NTCP process will continue to have community involvement, and TAB will retain authority to recommend final traffic calming measures to City Council. The updated NTCP will also include additional traffic calming measures descriptions and graphics to help clarify common questions.

Staff Recommends Approval. The Transportation and Advisory Board recommended approval by a vote of 4-0 to amend City's Neighborhood Traffic Calming Program.
