Strategic Plan Element:

The recommended action supports the goal of Organizational Effectiveness. Goal Statement: Achieve a high performing organization by nurturing an engaged workforce committed to a shared vision of public service.

Background:

The Sonoma County Mayors' and Councilmembers' Association represents every city within the County of Sonoma. It's voting members consist of a Mayor or alternate Councilmember from each of the member cities, chosen by their respective Councils. Their duties are to review policy items, make appointments as may be required or authorized, deal with issues affecting cities, and advocate for those on behalf of the cities within Sonoma County.

The City Selection Committee, the Board of Directors for the Sonoma County Mayors' and Councilmembers' Association, and the General Membership meetings are held on the second Thursday of the months of: February, April, June, August, and October. On April 10, 2025, the City Selection Committee and Mayors' and Councilmembers' Board of Directors will make appointments to upcoming vacancies on various committees.

The City Selection Committee and the Mayors' and Councilmembers' Association, which includes all the Sonoma-County cities, fill vacancies on various local or regional Boards or Commissions when the terms of office expire or upon resignation. The Chair of the City Selection and Mayors' and Councilmembers' Association requested letters of interest for the openings listed below. Copies of all submitted letters will be provided after the closing of the deadline, prior to the Town Council meeting.
